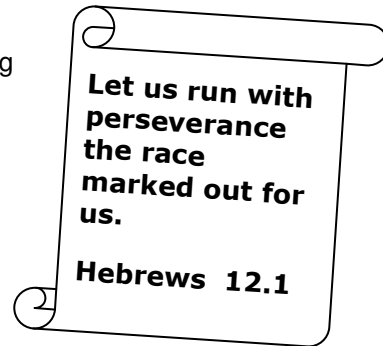

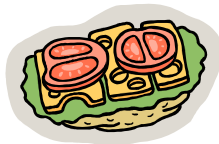

Growing Deep: Becoming a Prayer-Inspired Risk-Taker

From the second Sunday in August, the church will be starting an exciting 5-week church-wide prayer journey. This will involve each of us individually, as well as all home groups, and will be the focus of 5 or 6 Sunday services until mid-September. Other prayer events will happen over this period as well.

There will be daily reflection resources available for each of us, plus additional resources for home groups. As we did for the 40 Days of Purpose series several years ago, if you are not involved in a home group, please consider joining an existing group or forming some new ones with some church friends or neighbours for this period. Existing home groups meet on Monday evenings at TBCC (talk to Judy or Gordon), Tuesday evening in Tawa (talk to the Langham's or Steer's), Wednesday daytime (ladies group - talk to Verna) and Wednesday evening (two groups, one at the Burgess's and the other at one of the Inlet group's homes - talk to Robert Brace).

The daily reflections for everyone will be available by early August, to be distributed at church. The suggested donation to cover the cost is \$20 per copy, so please bring a \$20 note if you are able to on Sunday 1 August. They are a high-quality set of daily readings for five weeks, from authors such as Bill Hybels, Tony Campolo, Philip Yancy, Tom Wright, C.S. Lewis, John Piper, Richard Foster, Adrian Plass, and John Stott.

Home group resources will be provided as required, so let Judy McMillan or Mike Wood know if you are starting a new group for this series.

You will also be given a name card of a prayer buddy (like we have already done for the children) who will be praying especially for you over this time - you will know who your prayer buddy is, so you can get together if you wish. At our worship services, there will be opportunities to make prayer needs and praise points known to the wider church, if you wish. If you have any questions, please see Mike Wood.

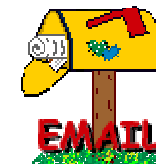
