Growing Deep: Becoming a Prayer-Inspired Risk-Taker

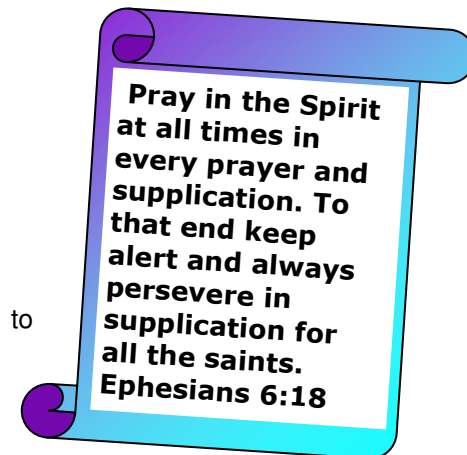

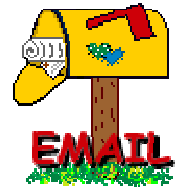
