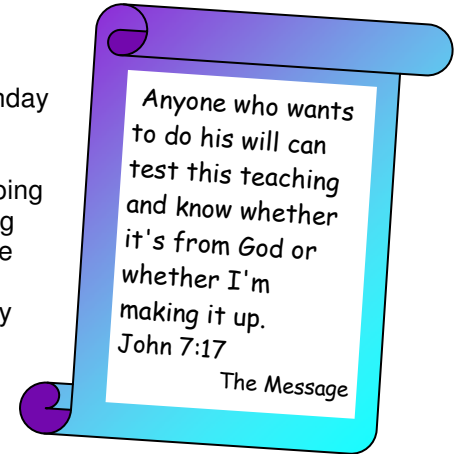
## For your Prayers & Praise

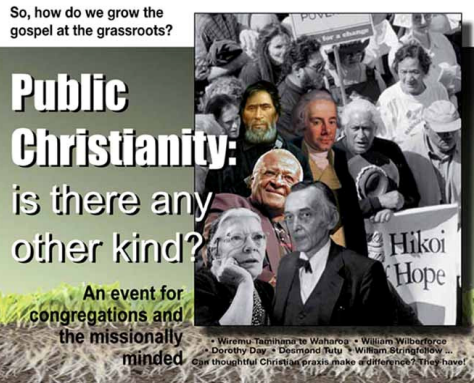
